

Relief Money in Response to the Earthquake Centered in the Kumamoto Region of Kumamoto Prefecture 2016

Following the Earthquake Centered in the Kumamoto Region of Kumamoto Prefecture 2016, the Government of Japan decided to accept relief money from foreign governments, foreign individuals, companies and Japanese residents abroad, in the following manner:

1. Information regarding Account of Embassy of Japan in Lithuania for Relief Money

(1) Embassy of Japan in Lithuania has opened the following account to accept relief money. Embassy of Japan in Lithuania extended the period of accepting the relief money until March 31st, 2019.

(note) The relief money received by the Embassy of Japan in Lithuania will be sent to the account of the Government of Japan later. After relief money is received by the Embassy of Japan in Lithuania and sent to the account of the Government of Japan, the money will be delivered to the affected people through local governments.

The acceptance of the “Gien-kin (donations)”to the Japanese Red Cross Society via Embassy of Japan in Lithuania’s account has ended on July 30th 2016.

3. “Kyuen-kin (relief funds)”to Japanese Red Cross Society’s accounts

The fundraising of the “Kyuen-kin (relief funds)”on the Japanese Red Cross Society’s overseas account has ended on July 15th 2016.
