35 YEAR HISTORY OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN JAPAN AND LITHUANIA

- 20 December 1922 – Japan recognized the Republic of Lithuania
- 10 October 1991 – Diplomatic relations were restored**

CHIUNE SUGIHARA

Chiune Sugihara was born in 1900 in Gifu Prefecture. He began his diplomatic service in 1924, and in 1939 he was appointed to serve at the Japanese Consulate in Kaunas.

In July 1940, as the Soviet occupation and annexation of Lithuania approached, Jewish refugees from Poland flooded the Japanese Consulate seeking transit visas. After much deliberation, Sugihara decided to issue transit visas to Jewish refugees. Within one month, he issued more than 2,000 so-called “visas for life.”

For this humanitarian act, in 1985 the Yad Vashem Institute

awarded Chiune Sugihara the title of Righteous Among the Nations. After his death, in 1992 the monument Moonlight was erected in his honor at the Holocaust Museum in Vilnius, and in 1993 Chiune Sugihara was honored by the Government of Lithuania.

In 1999, the Sugihara House Museum was established in Kaunas. Commemorating the 100th anniversary of Sugihara's birth, a memorial plaque dedicated to him was unveiled at the Diplomatic Archives of Japan in 2000, and 100 cherry trees were planted in Vilnius, forming a park named after Chiune Sugihara. Sugihara is buried at the Kamakura City Cemetery. The year 2026 marks the 40th anniversary of Chiune Sugihara's passing.”
